COMMUTING PATTERNS

Our Values

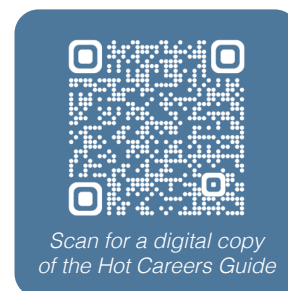
